


This quiz book tests your knowledge about football.

Question 1

Which game was the first international match to be officially recognised?

- 1 George against Dragon
- 2 Goblins against Villagers
- 3 England against Scotland

Answer

The first official international football match took place in 1872 when England played against Scotland.



Question 2

On average, roughly how far does a footballer run during a game of football?

- 1 The length of 100 earthworms
- 2 To the moon and back
- 3 The length of 1,000 school buses

Answer

On average, football players run 9.65 kilometres in a game.

That's almost the length of 1,000 school buses if you park them in a line!




Question 3

Which record was broken at the 2015 FIFA Women's World Cup Final?

- 1 Fastest hat trick (three goals) in a World Cup final ever.
- 2 Largest football ever used. It was the size of a small elephant.
- 3 Most overgrown grass ever recorded. It was as high as the players' shoulders!

Answer

The hat trick scored by Carli Lloyd was the fastest ever in a World Cup final. She scored three goals in thirteen minutes!



Question 4

Apart from playing football, what causes the most injuries on the pitch?

- 1 Angry seagull attacks
- 2 Lightning strikes
- 3 Celebrating goals

Answer

Footballers often hurt themselves whilst celebrating goals.

This is because they try to do tricks to show how excited they are and these sometimes lead to injuries.



Question 5

According to the official Laws of the Game, what is an 'outside agent'?

- 1 A spy that pretends to play for the opposing team but deliberately messes things up and confuses them.
- 2 An unexpected object, or a person that is not on the team list or a match official.
- 3 A player that kicks the ball into the goal from the car park outside.

Answer


An 'outside agent' is anything unofficial that interferes with the game or a person that is not on the team list or a match official.



Question 6

Which one of these items must a referee have?

Answer

A referee must have a whistle.

They must also have a watch, red and yellow cards and a notebook or some other way of making notes.



Question 7

Which of these is a real move in football?


- 1 Scorpion kick
- 2 Rhinosaurus shuffle
- 3 Lazy hamster



Answer

A **Scorpion kick** is when a player dives forward and their knees and feet flick backwards so the player looks just like a scorpion.

Then they kick the ball with their heels sending it back where it came from. It's an amazingly difficult and skilful move!



Question 8

What was strange about a goal scored in 2009 by a British team?

- 1 A dog caught the ball and ran into the goal with it.
- 2 A small earthquake made the pitch rise up and the ball rolled into the net while no one was looking.
- 3 The football bounced off a beach ball before flying into the net.



Answer

The football bounced off a beach ball that a boy from the crowd had thrown on to the pitch. The match referee didn't have a clear view.


He thought the ball bounced off of another player, and he allowed the goal to count!



Question 9

Which odd reason did Manchester United give for losing a match?

- 1 Their kit was so grey they couldn't see their teammates.
- 2 All the players on the other team were wearing silly masks.

Answer

Manchester United complained that they couldn't see their teammates because their kit was so grey.

They even changed kit at half time!

It didn't help. They still lost the game.



Question 10

What does VAR stand for?


- 1 Very Angry Rabbit

Answer

VAR stands for the **Video Assistant Referee** who is a football official.
